- The annual median revenue growth for PEO users is twice that of comparable non-PEO users.
- Small businesses that work with a PEO grow 7 to 9% faster, have employee turnover that is 10 to 14% lower, and are 50 % less likely to go out of business.
- Businesses who work with a PEO are 16 percent more likely to report an increase in profitability.
- PEO users are significantly less concerned than non-PEO users about their ability to handle key business challenges such as hiring employees, increasing revenues, and raising capital and/or funding.
